For First Time Users:

1. Go to <https://clarkcountyooh.rbdigital.com/> on your computer to access the library's RBdigital collection in a web browser.

2. Select REGISTER to create an account or SIGN IN with an existing account. For new users, enter your library card and user information. Check box to accept the terms and conditions. Click REGISTER.

Note: If you receive this message, "A patron account with the specified username, email address, or card number already exists for this library." You may already created a RBdigital account if you used you these services in the past: RBdigital Magazines (Zinio) or Transparent Online Language.

3. After signing in, RBdigital will open to the library's collection homepage.

4. Select Acorn TV listed under Entertainment.

5. Select a series or film for more detailed summary then select CHECKOUT to checkout a 7-day access pass. Acorn TV will open in your desktop browser. Select OK to confirm your 7-day checkout access pass. You'll receive a "Welcome to Acorn TV" email.

6. Acorn TV loads. Select ACCESS ACORN TV.

7. Select an episode to play.

8. After the 7th day, return to <https://clarkcountyooh.rbdigital.com/> to check out another 7-day access to resume viewing your content.

2. Once the app is installed, log in with your existing RBdigital credentials to access Acorn TV on your tablet or smartphone device. *Note: You can not checkout 7-day RBdigital access pass through the Acorn TV app.*



Frequently Asked Questions

What is Acorn TV? Acorn TV is a subscription streaming service that offers world-class British mysteries, dramas, comedies, and documentaries, all commercial-free. You can binge-watch fan favorites like Doc Martin, A Place to Call Home, Murdoch Mysteries, The Brokenwood Mysteries, Midsomer Murders, and Foyle's War, as well as Acorn TV Originals you can't stream anywhere else, including Agatha Raisin, Loch Ness, Striking Out, and Detectorists. New shows are added weekly.

Which devices support Acorn TV? All you need is an Internet connection and a device to watch on. Acorn TV is currently available on Roku, Amazon Fire TV and Fire TV stick, Apple TV (tvOS version), iPhone/iPad, Android smartphones and tablets, Chromecast, and on laptops, desktops, and tablets via browser (we strongly recommend using Google Chrome to access Acorn TV).

Do I need a subscription to access Acorn TV? Not with your RBdigital account. After your 7-day RBdigital access pass expires, Acorn TV will prompt you to sign up for an Acorn TV subscription. **DO NOT SELECT SUBSCRIBE.** Instead, go back to library's RBdigital collection page via a web browser and simply check out another 7-day access pass to continue watching Acorn TV. *Note: You can not checkout 7-day RBdigital access pass through the Acorn TV app.*

Can Acorn TV episodes or films be downloaded to my device for offline viewing? No. They cannot be downloaded any digital content from Acorn to your device. You must have Internet collection in order to play Acorn TV content.
