



# The Great Courses Library Collection

## Unlimited Access to a World of Knowledge from RBDigital

### For First Time Users:

1. Go to <https://clarkcountyoh.rbdigital.com/> on your computer to access the library's RBDigital collection in a web browser.

2. Select REGISTER to create an account or SIGN IN with an existing account. For new users, enter your library card and user information. Check box to accept the terms and conditions. Click REGISTER.

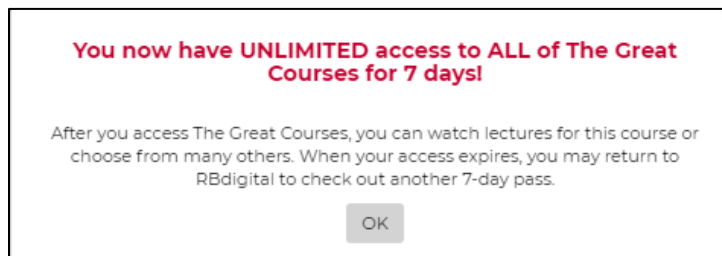
*Note: If you receive this message, "A patron account with the specified username, email address, or card number already exists for this library." You may already created a RBDigital account if you used you these services in the past: RBDigital Magazines (Zinio) or Transparent Online Language.*

The registration form is divided into three main sections: LOGIN INFORMATION, YOUR INFORMATION, and LIBRARY INFORMATION. The LOGIN INFORMATION section includes fields for USERNAME, PASSWORD, and CONFIRM PASSWORD. The YOUR INFORMATION section includes fields for FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, EMAIL, CONFIRM EMAIL, and POSTAL CODE. The LIBRARY INFORMATION section includes a field for LIBRARY CARD. At the bottom, there is a checkbox for accepting Terms of Service and Privacy Policy, a note that asterisks indicate required fields, and two buttons: CANCEL and REGISTER with a right-pointing arrow. 3. After signing in, RBDigital will open to the library's collection homepage.

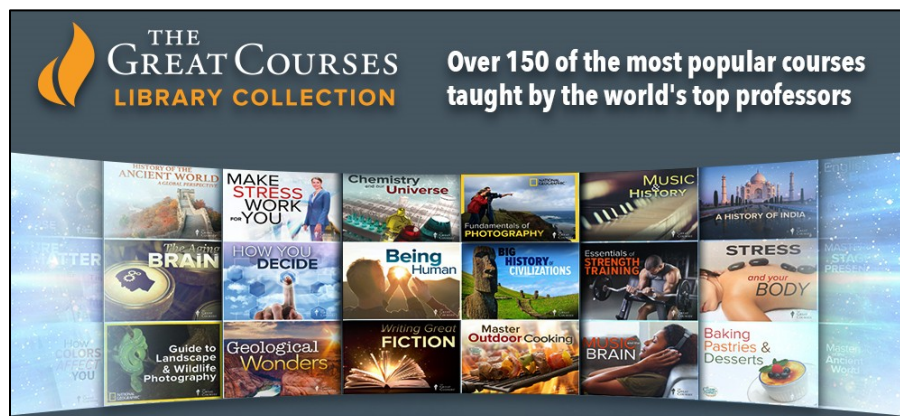
4. Select The Great Courses listed under Entertainment.

5. Select a course for more detailed summary then select CHECKOUT to checkout a 7-day access pass. The Great Courses Library Collection will open in your desktop or mobile browser. Select OK to confirm your 7-day checkout access pass.



6. The course will open in a new tab. Select PLAY to start lecture. Select Guidebook to download a PDF Guidebook for the course.

7. After the 7<sup>th</sup> day, return to <https://clarkcountyoh.rbdigital.com/> to check out another 7-day access to resume viewing your content.

**What is The Great Courses Library Collection?** The Great Courses Library Collection is a subscription video on demand service provided by RBDigital. With thousands of in-depth videos by the world's greatest professors, you'll always have something fascinating to learn about. There are never any commercials no matter how much you watch, and you can pause, rewind, fast forward or re-watch as often as you like.

**What devices can I use to stream The Great Courses Library Collection?** The Great Courses Library Collection can be enjoyed on the web using a desktop, laptop, tablet or smartphone. You must have an active internet connection to stream videos and we recommend using the most current version of the browser. The Great Courses Library Collection works well with Safari, Chrome, and Firefox. Unfortunately, there is no app for The Great Courses Library Collection.

**How many times can I stream a lecture?** You can stream any lectures as many times as you want. After your 7-day RBDigital pass expires, go back to the library's RBDigital collection page at <https://clarkcountyoh.rbdigital.com/> via a web browser and simply check out another 7-day access pass to continue watching your lectures.

**Are the guidebooks available for the courses?** Guidebooks are available on the course page. You may view them as PDFs on screen or you can download them to your computer and print them.

**I am having difficulty streaming videos. What should I do?** If you are having difficulty streaming a video, first check your device to make sure that you have a strong and stable internet connection.
